Thank you for your correspondence dated and received March 30, 2021, regarding consultation of the aforementioned project under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, as amended (54 USC § 306108), and its implementing regulations, 36 CFR Part 800.

We have reviewed all documentation submitted for this project and agree the defined area of potential effect (APE) is appropriate for the undertaking. We concur the identified nine (9) properties are *not eligible* for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places. Those nine properties are identified with the following Smithsonian site numbers: 5DV.47404; 5DV.47406; 5DV.47408; 5DV.47410; 5DV.47412; 5DV.47416; 5DV.47426; 5DV.47637; 5DV.47638. None of the nine identified properties are located within known or documented historic districts. Thus, we concur the undertaking as described will result in *no historic properties affected* regarding the aforementioned nine properties.

We request being involved in the consultation process with the local government, which as stipulated in 36 CFR §800.3 is required to be notified of the undertaking, and with other consulting parties. Additional information provided by the local government or consulting parties might cause our office to re-evaluate our eligibility and potential effect findings. Please note that our compliance letter does not end the 30-day review period provided to other consulting parties.

Determinations of National Register eligibility subject to this letter were made in consultation pursuant to the implementing regulations of Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act, 36 CFR Part 800. Please note other Federal programs such as the National Register of Historic Places and the Federal Investment Tax Credit Program may have additional documentation and evaluation standards. Final determinations remain the responsibility of the Keeper of the National Register.
